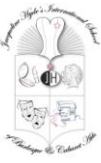

Classes are kept small to promote a better one to one environment. Certificate Programs

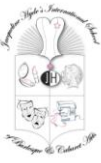
Teaser Program: For students who want to get their feet wet in the Burlesque arts, and graduate with skills to get started. This smaller course focuses on the basic aspects of burlesque. Graduates of this class will learn the burlesque basics enough to be novice performer. This is a beginners course, and could be considered like an associates' degree. Completing the Teaser program allows for enrollment of the Master's Program Classes. Master's entrance from Teaser's requires sign off by Jacqueline Hyde.

Master's Program: For students seeking to be a polished professional upon completion of this course. It is a 13-week course focusing on every aspect of being an entertainer. During the 13 weeks, students will receive classes as well as six private lessons. Classes are three hours long with additional one on one time. Graduates of this class will learn not only burlesque arts, dance elements, hosting techniques, but also techniques in modeling. Graduates will receive a digital photo portfolio and graduation video.

Professional Instructor's Certification: Completion of the Master's Program is required. Application along with a short essay is required to be considered for this program. Only two spots will be open each 13-week quarter for the PIC program. The PIC is a separate program from the other certificate programs, requiring apprenticeship, and weekly meeting with Jacqueline. If you are interested, please consult with Jacqueline.

General Classes / Other Classes

One Off Classes: For individuals seeking to take classes on a less demanding schedule. Does not include completion of any certificate, but does count as credit towards certificate programs. Classes are not the standard rate of tuition. Please see the Tuition section of this course catalogue.



JHISBCA Burlesque Virtual (Online Program): For individuals not in the area of school locations, online programs have been established. They vary in price based upon the lessons being taught and range from a 5 minute instructional video to 45 minutes. An Online Certificate Program is available.

Graduation Policies

To participate in recital/graduation: those who wish to be in the graduation show must complete the Teaser or Master's Program.

Those Participating in graduation: Students who participate in the graduation show are required to sell a minimum of 10 tickets. This ensures 1: there will be audience 2: Fulfills skills on networking and self-promotion, learned in BIZ101. School will promote as well.

Online Certification Policies

Those students who have taken the courses required for online certification will receive a certificate of completion in the mail.

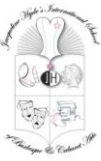
Code of Conduct

Age Requirements: No one under the age of 18 can participate in these classes - ID required. Many cases, performance opportunities require performers to be 21 years of age. The Jacqueline Hyde International School of Burlesque an Cabaret Arts abides by rules regarding adult entertainment, and standard theaters, Not nightclubs, bars or establishments that serve alcohol requiring the performers age to be 21. Please inquire with the producer as to the minimum age requirement for the performance.

Dress Code: A leotard or dance attire must be worn at all times in the studio during active/dance lessons and in-studio rehearsals. Pasties and "Unders" must be worn during formal rehearsals. You may wear clothing suited to your developed character or comfortable attire, at all other times. Some days you may be requested to come as character, and your instructor will note said days. Dance shoes (Ballet, Jazz, character or Ballroom) or Burlesque only shoes are requested (NO Street Shoes Please).

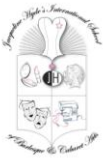
Class Size: Limit of 10 students per course/ program, some classes have "one Off" options are first come first serve, and a waiting list will be provided.

Release Forms: all students will sign a release form that will be kept on file with Jacqueline Hyde's International School of Burlesque and cabaret Arts. Failure to sign said documents will result in the inability to participate in any classes. Note: required with online registration to be completed.



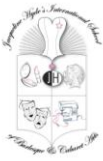
Smoking: No smoking inside the school or theaters. Please go outside should you need a smoke break.

Food and Drink: No food or drinks with the exception of water stored on the shelves in the dance space or waiting area. During rehearsals and productions, please refrain from drinking any adult beverages, especially backstage. Water and some juices will be provided in designated area backstage during rehearsals. Please no food in the theater during rehearsals or productions. In addition, for heaven's sake-throw away your cups!
